- Small school (262 students) located minutes from the Naval Academy
- Transportation provided before and after care to NSA Annapolis Youth Center

Bates Middle School

- 701 Chase St., Annapolis, MD 21401
- 410-263-0270
- Approximately 600 students
- Home of the Performing and Visual Arts Program (magnet school)

Annapolis High School

- 2700 Riva Road, Annapolis, MD 21401
- 410-266-5240
- Home to the International Baccalaureate Program
- Approximately 1,600 students



If you live NSA Annapolis Housing (also called North Severn), your public schools are:

Annapolis Elementary School*

- 180 Green St., Annapolis, MD 21401
 - 410-222-1600
 - Small school (185 students) in the heart of historic Annapolis
- *Elementary-aged children living on Worden Field at the Naval Academy attend Annapolis Elementary, also.

- Approximately 800 students

Broadneck High School

How to enroll

Mandatory documents for enrolling your child in Anne Arundel County Public Schools are:

1. Residency documentation

- Mortgage papers, apartment lease or [Tenant residence verification form](#)

2. Supporting document (one of the following)

- Utility, telephone or cable bill
- Current bank statement
- Current pay stub
- Income tax notice
- W-2 form
- Valid driver's license
- Social security check
- Domestic relations (child support)
- Passport

3. Evidence of birth (one or more of the following)

- Birth certificate (preferred)
- Passport or Visa
- Physician's certificate
- Birth registration
- Baptism certificate
- Church certificate
- Hospital certificate

4. Medical records (all required)

- Immunization (shot) record (see [Vaccination Requirements for Children Enrolled in Preschool Programs and in Schools - State of MD](#))
- Lead certificate for students entering PreKindergarten, Kindergarten or first grade
- Record of physical examination for students entering a Maryland public school for the first time. (Exam must have been completed within the last nine months.)

5. If applicable

- Court-ordered child custody document (if one exists)
- Maryland Transfer Form SR7, if transferring from another Maryland Public School
- Copy of last report card or high school transcript
- Special Services documents (current IEP, evaluations; 504 plan; ESOL services; or gifted/talented)
