

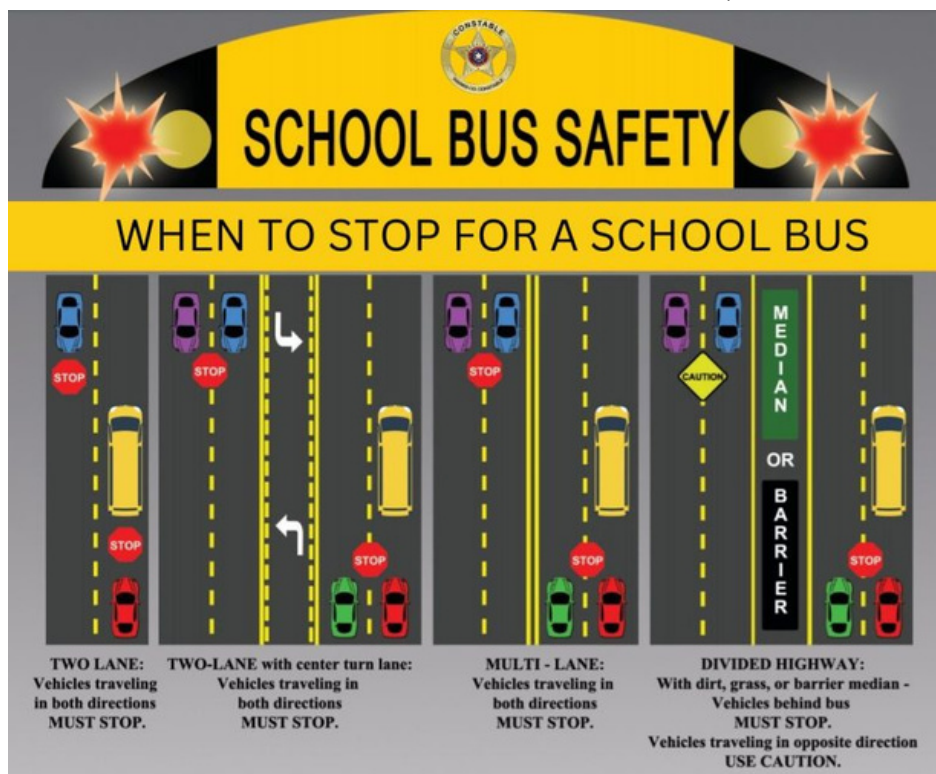


Back to school already? Bus stops, orientations, and traffic
