PREKINDERGARTEN: Registration for the 2019-2020 school year begins February 6, 2019

AACPS Prekindergarten programs offer a high-quality educational experience to eligible children in order to prepare them with the foundational knowledge and skills necessary for school success in Kindergarten and beyond.

Prekindergarten is strictly for children who turn four on or before September. A half-day or full-day Prekindergarten program for four year olds is offered in some elementary schools. A non-
