TAP Pre-Separation Brief
(Prerequisite to attending the TAP course)

This congressionally mandated brief must be completed by all service members 365 Days prior to separation/retirement. Pre-Separation/Transition Counseling provides information on various benefits, programs, services, tools, and other important resource entitlements for which members may be eligible pursuant to, and accordance with DoD regulations/instructions. Open to all Services and Pay Grades. (v) = virtual

TAP Core Curriculum and MY Employment Track

From start to finish, TAP provides participants with information on VA benefits, medical benefits, education options, and navigating and preparing for civilian or federal employment. The first three days include DoD's mandatory core curriculum for transitioning/retiring out of the military. The remaining two days offer the "My Employment" Track. Open to all Services and Pay Grades.

Executive TAP (ETAP) Core Curriculum and MY Employment Track

This course is very similar to the course above. **ETAP is specifically designated for E-9 and O5+ only.** Open to all Services.

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MY Entrepreneurship Track (AKA: Boots to Business)

A 2-day workshop offered in collaboration with the U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA), the Institute for Veterans and Military Families at Syracuse University (IVMF), the Department of Defense and the Department of Veterans Affairs. Participants will learn about building business plans, strategies for starting a business, veteran eligible loan programs, support resources available, and more.

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MY Education Track

A 2-day workshop to better prepare transitioning service members who are considering pursuing higher education. You will learn about the process of selecting a degree program, comparing accredited colleges, examining a range of funding sources, and completing your college application package. University Fairs may be conducted as part of this workshop.

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MY Vocational Track (Virtual)

A 2-day workshop that offers participants the opportunity to identify skills and learn about training and credentialing programs. Participants will also complete career development assessments of occupational interests and abilities. Participants will leave with an action plan to achieve their career goals.
